

EURAMET 2030 Vision




Vision: EURAMET to be the leader in the development and application of measurement science enabling Europe to be competitive, healthy and sustainable through innovation.





EURAMET legal status






In 2007, to operate the European Metrology Research Program and to receive and spend funds from the European Commission, EUROMET needed to become a legal entity.


EURAMET

EURAMET was born as an association of public utility under German law able to both, operate the metrology research programmes and the other purposes of EUROMET as the European RMO.

EURAMET Structure







The **Secretariat** is financed by the **Membership fees**. Tasks of the Secretariat concerning the metrology research programmes are financed by contributions of the research programme Members. The **MSU** is subcontracted and financed by the **contributions of the research program members**.

EURAMET projects



- a) Comparisons: Comparisons can be Key Comparisons (KC), Supplementary Comparisons (SC) or Pilot Studies.
- b) Consultation: knowledge transfer activities between EURAMET members. This project type comprises, among others, direct consultation among NMIs/DIs, expert meetings, training courses and workshops, peer reviews of Quality Management Systems within TC-Q, studies, preparation of guidance documents, drafting and revision of calibration guides.
- c) Cooperation in Research: research projects between EURAMET members, which are not funded by the European Metrology Research Programmes.
- d) **Traceability:** Documentation of agreements between EURAMET members (formal or informal) for provision of metrological traceability.

The activities of the EURAMET members in these projects are funded by the members themselves. The EURAMET Secretariat:

- register new projects, register changes and progress of existing projects in the TC project database;
- consult coordinator and TC Chair in case of open questions, missing information and observed inconsistencies....

The European Partnership on Metrology

Objective: to provide effective metrological solutions to technological and societal challenges, as well as increase collaborative research between industry and academia

- A robust, **sustainable, excellent and coordinated** European Metrology Infrastructure
- To ensure state-of-the-art metrology R&D taken up by innovators
- To increase impact of metrology (industry, Society..)
- Address European and global challenges, including:
 - European Green Deal
 - European industry strategy, KET, digital transition
 - Better Health for All

The Management Support Unit is subcontracted and responsible for running the EPM. It is financed by the contributions of the research program members.









The budget for EURAMET member services is agreed by the General Assembly (GA) each year including the total contributions expected from the members.

The fees for individual Members and Associates are determined by the GA in terms of:

- a. A **unit charge** as a basis for the charge to Members, Corresponding Applicants (A-CA) and Associates with an observer in the GA (A-GA)
 - a. Members are then charged the unit charge times the factor for their country (based on the UN coefficient)
 - b. A-CA and A-GA are charged 0.5 times the unit charge, times the factor for their country
- c. A common fee to be charged to all Associate Designated Institutes, independent of their country
