AFRIMETS -MOU

- ARIMETS was established in July 2007 to promote international, intra-African, and regional cooperation in metrology.
- AFRIMETS was accepted by International Committee of Weights and Measures (CIPM) of the International Bureau of Weights and Measures (BIPM) as the RMO representing Africa in October 2008.
- Currently, AFRIMET membership for African institutions are principle (for full SRMOs members) or ordinary membership (not full member of SRMOs).

Sub-Regional Metrology Organizations

- The necessity and urgent need for a strong, sustainable and integrated approach to the continent's quality infrastructure, that group the NMIs, with its metrological capabilities, call for the establishment of Sub-Regional Metrological Organizations in all Africa.
- Currently, within Africa, 5 SRMOs are in operation.
- It was clear that some countries of Africa are not represented by a sub-regional metrology body.




Establishing a New SRMO

Representatives of Five African countries have signed an MOU for the establishment of the NEWMET- SRMO :

- National Institute for Standards of Egypt (NIS)
- Standards Organization of Nigeria (SON)
- Ghana Standards Board (GSB)
- Quality and Standards Authority of Ethiopia (QSAE)
- Libyan National Centre for Standardisation and Metrology (LNCSM)

The Sudanese Standards & Metrology Organization (SSMO) agreed to join the NEWMET but did not sign yet.






Four of them are already Ordinary Members of AFRIMETS, namely

Sunday 21 June 2009

- A new sub- regional metrology organization has been formed of countries from North, East and West Africa continent, hereinafter called NEWMET on Sunday 21 June 2009 in Cairo upon the invitation from NIS.
- The delegates discussed the items of the MOU of the New SRMO.
- The name of the New SRMO was chosen to be North, East and West Africa Metrology Organization (NEWMET).





MOU Focal Points

We, Egypt (NIS), Nigeria (SON), Ghana (GSB), Ethiopia (QSAE), Libyan (LNCSM) and Sudan (SSMO) resolve to:

- Create a new SRMO to represent the North -East and Western parts of Africa; named the (NEWMET) and to join AFRIMETS, the umbrella body for Metrology Cooperation in Africa.
- The NEWAMET will be an open non-exclusive partnership to stimulate collaboration in the area of Measurement standards and Measurement in the sub region.



NEWMET Satisfied with AFRIMETS-MOU



- NEWMET-SRMO is satisfied with the AFRIMETS-MOU and has submitted an application for consideration as principal members of AFRIMETS.
- We Hope that our new membership will be effective toward supporting the metrology in Africa.
