ROLE OF OIML [1]

- To develop mutual information
- To determine the general principles of legal metrology and harmonize legal metrology regulations
- To draw up guidance documents for inspections and checking of measuring instruments



ROLE OF OIML [2]

- To set up certification systems
- To promote mutual recognitions
- To promote closer relations between the different services responsible for legal metrology at national level
- To facilitate cooperation with and assistance to developing countries

RLMO Objectives


- Identify special features to be addressed
