- 59 Member States
- 67 Corresponding Members
- Some Corresponding Members re-joining after settling previous debts
- Corresponding Member fee for 2014 is 1 400 €
 - set by 14th OIML Conference (Bucharest, 2012)
 - equals 10 % minimum Member State fee
- Procedure to join as Corresponding Member is simple and quick

New OIML web site



Focus of next few years' work

- Completion of BIML renovation
- Continued development of database facilities:
 - Workspaces for all project groups
 - Extension of online voting facilities to committee drafts
- Improvements to technical work:
 - Completion of review of need for inactive projects
 - Close follow-up of other current projects
 - Follow-up of non-participating P-members
 - BIML to initiate reviews of existing publications (normally done on five-year cycle)





- 76 current projects
- 10 projects need new conveners
- 10 conveners did not reply to request for update in February 2014
 - 8 of these are from one country
- In the second second
 - B 6 requires six P-members from at least two different regions so that work can be considered international rather than regional

- Even as Corresponding Members, AFRIMETS members can influence the development and contents of OIML Recommendations
- Can register as O-members on any project group
- Need to <u>participate</u> in the OIML's technical work
- Most activities are now conducted electronically
- Comments welcome from Corresponding Members registered with project groups, although they cannot vote





- B 6 requires publication reviews every five years
- 82 % of the 128 Recommendations on the OIML web site are more than five years old
- 69 % of the 128 Documents on the OIML web site are more than five years old
- Not currently obvious which have been reconfirmed since confirmation date not indicated
- Some are currently under revision
