
Institutional and technical capabilities to implement WTO requirements (TBT/SPS) enhanced





- Current project until August 2019; very good evaluation results
- German government reconfirmed its readiness to continue its support.
- Follow-up project is envisaged to start in September 2019
   (3 years, 3 Mio. EUR); focus on implementation of th AfCFTA TBT Annex and Boosting Intra-African Trade (BIAT)
- Support to the Pan-African Quality Infrastructure (including AFRIMETS) will be maintained




# Support to PAQI

Ongoing: Development of a common Pan-African Quality Policy (PAQP) as a requirement of the Abuja Treaty

- Draft Document was prepared
- Consultation Workshops with all AU member states
  - > 1st consultation workshop in Nairobi on 22/23 July (COMESA, EAC, SADC, UMA)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> consultation workshop in Abuja on 29/30 July (ECCAS, ECOWAS)
- Validation workshop on 8 August (AUC, PAQI, other stakeholders)

Be aware of possible consultations before the July workshops at national level and contribute!





### Way forward


AfCFTA is started. PAQI plays an active role for the implementation of the AfCFTA TBT Annex requirements.

PAQI will identify common activities, but each PAQI pillar must work in its area of expertise.

#### For AFRIMETS:

- Mutual recognition agreements concerning calibration certificates
- Mutual Acceptance Arrangements for verification procedures (technical regulations)
- Transparent custom procedures (e.g. weighing bridges on check-points)

Further PTB support is confirmed (demand oriented and performance driven)
